








Medicare Reporting

We request that for each claim alleging bodily injury and/or emotional distress, claimants provide:

-  Full legal name
-  Date of birth
-  Gender
-  Social Security Number
-  Health Insurance Claim Number (HICN)

This enables United Educators (UE) to meet our reporting requirements under the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Extension Act (MMSEA). Section 111 of the MMSEA sets forth mandatory notice and reporting requirements under the Medicare Secondary Payer Statute relating to liability and no-fault cases.

As of Jan. 1, 2010, Section 111 placed an affirmative obligation on UE to determine if a plaintiff/claimant is a Medicare beneficiary and notify Medicare of settlements, judgments, awards, or other payments to or on behalf of Medicare beneficiaries. The penalty for failing to report any settlement, award or payment to a Medicare beneficiary is severe. Therefore, UE must have the requested information to verify a claimant's Medicare status and comply with the reporting obligations provided by Section 111 before issuing any payment.
