

2019 RMPC Program Highlights

Reduce Your 2019 Renewal Premium With Sustained Risk Management

Since 2006, United Educators (UE) has rewarded members who have taken action to reduce risk at their school, college, or university with a risk management premium credit (RMPC). Many members have participated in this program, impacting risk at their own institution to reduce claims, and benefitting the entire UE membership by doing so.

Member success with the program has enabled UE to offer members the opportunity to **earn a 6 percent discount on their renewal premium** through the RMPC for the third year in a row. The program involves two phases and specific milestones for implementation, designed to help the member sustain risk management activities throughout the entire 2018-2019 policy period.

It's important to get an early start on working toward your institution's 2019 RMPC. The qualifying activities described below are time-sensitive, and to earn the full premium discount, members should initiate activity immediately after their 2018 renewal or new policy issuance (with effective dates between May 1, 2018 and April 30, 2019). Credits earned for completed qualifying activities will be awarded on the 2019 renewal (between May 1, 2019 and April 30, 2020) of their UE policies.

2019 RMPC Schedule of Activities

PHASE I: INFORMATION EXCHANGE, Initial 3 percent <i>Qualifying activities in Phase I focus on an exchange of information between UE and the member so that we can understand the risks at your institution and offer solutions relevant to your environment.</i>	
Within four months of renewal or new policy effective date	To complete this phase of the RMPC, members must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Complete the following, which will be emailed upon renewal or new policy effective date: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Risk Management Survey, a two-part survey regarding risk management and your relationship with UE. PHASE II: RISK MITIGATION, Final 3 percent to earn full 6 percent credit

This phase of the RMPC focuses on partnering with UE to implement a risk mitigation activity. Members pursuing Phase II will be asked to explore a set of UE resources and complete an intake form stating their activity for the year (e.g. using a UE online learning course, updating a policy or procedure, etc.) Available topics of risk are:*

- Contracts, Waivers, and Risk Transfer
- Crisis Management **NEW**
- Data Security **NEW**
- Enterprise Risk Management **NEW**
- Protecting Children
- Protecting Student and Patient Privacy **NEW**
- Student Sexual Violence Prevention (Higher Ed Only)
- Study Abroad
- Transportation
- Tenure Management **NEW**
- Workplace Harassment

***Note: Members must complete and submit their intake form within five months of renewal or new policy issuance.**

<p>Within 10 months of renewal or new policy issuance</p>	<p>Final activity to earn the RMPC:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Members who implemented online learning will be required to have trained a majority of the relevant learning population. <input type="checkbox"/> For any other activity, members will be required to complete an activity summary form and submit relevant supporting documentation (such as an updated policy or procedure) as evidence of completion. <i>Please note that while we will not be evaluating or auditing these documents, members will have the opportunity to grant us permission to share their documentation as a best practice if warranted.</i>
<p>CONGRATULATIONS!</p>	<p>Completion of the Information Exchange and Risk Mitigation phases within 10 months of your policy renewal qualifies you for a full 6 percent premium discount.</p>

PLEASE NOTE: This RMPC program does not apply to K-12 public school members or members that purchase in groups. Those purchasing as part of a group should refer to group RMPC requirements.
